The Spring Term Clubs for all full time children will begin on Monday 15th January 2018 and end week beginning Monday 12th March. The Clubs being offered this term are shown on the accompanying timetable and are offered on a totally voluntary basis by the staff team at Priory. **Please tick the club(s) that your child wishes to take part in and return by the end of school on Wednesday 10th January 2018.**

All club replies should be handed in to the school office. Any forms received after the closing date will not be considered. If your child is absent from school, please make arrangements to return the form by the closing date to avoid disappointment. Please do not leave replies in book bags or hand to members of staff.

As spaces in all clubs are limited the replies will be dealt with on a 'first come first served' basis. Children who were unsuccessful in a club last time will be given priority places this term. If a child gained a place in a club but failed to attend, then unfortunately they will not be considered for a place in that club again this term. As you can appreciate this is the only fair way to assign places.

Please be aware KS2 children will need to bring 50p for every cooking session and children need their own recorder for Recorder Club. Our 'Friendships in the Community Club' will see a small group of children walk to and from Westwood Care Home to spend half an hour making friends and working together on small projects. The 'Gifts for Giving' will be time for making a variety of gifts that can be given to others through schemes such as the Samaritans, 'Christmas Child' shoebox appeal. **Offers of help from parents and carers would be much appreciated for this club.** The new club, 'Thinking it Through' will provide opportunities for experimenting and encourage children to think, create and apply some interesting ideas!

Most after school clubs will finish at 4.15pm and children will be dismissed by a member of staff from the main entrance at that time. Football Club finishes at 4.30pm and children can be collected from the side gate into the playground. **Can we please ask that children are collected promptly from their club.** Twilight will continue to the end of term as usual even though other Clubs will have finished.
